**PRICES** Duty Paid and In Bond Prices are quoted in £ Sterling per case of 12 bottles, unless otherwise stated. The minimum order for duty paid delivered goods is 10 cases. A small order delivery surcharge of £6.00 may be levied on orders of less than ten cases. The minimum order for in bond delivered goods is 50 cases. Ex-cellars orders are quoted per case or per bottle in the currency of the country of origin. Minimum order is 50 cases.

All Duty Paid prices are subject to V.A.T. at the rate applicable at time of ordering.

**SUPPLIES** All items are offered subject to remaining available.

**COLLECTION ALLOWANCE** £0.60 per case for goods collected from our Warehouses.

**PAYMENT TERMS** CASH WITH ORDER (for which a 3% Allowance is made), unless Credit Facilities have been granted. Customers wishing to open a Credit Account are asked to provide details of two Trade suppliers with whom references may be taken up, as well as a Bank reference.

Customers with Credit Accounts are asked to note that PAYMENT IN FULL MUST BE RECEIVED BY WHICLAR & GORDON WINES LIMITED WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF INVOICE. SHOULD ANY ACCOUNT OR PART THEREOF REMAIN UNPAID BY THE 28th DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THAT IN WHICH THE GOODS WERE INVOICED, THE WHOLE OF THE ACCOUNT, WHETHER DUE OR NOT, SHALL BECOME PAYABLE IMMEDIATELY.

**TITLE** Title in the goods shall be retained by the Seller until payment in full of the price, and until such payment by the Buyer shall hold the goods and all items incorporating the goods in a fiduciary capacity for the Seller.

If your order does not arrive within 21 days from the date of our invoice, please contact us.

Unless these conditions are met, we shall not be able to claim from the carrier, and will regrettably therefore not be able to replace or credit any goods broken, short-delivered or not delivered.
