S<sup>r</sup>: Arnold Braams Esq. (born in  
Doxe, & Baptized as p<sup>y</sup> Register  
of S<sup>t</sup>: Maries in that Count doth  
appear: October y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>d</sup>: An<sup>o</sup>: Dom<sup>i</sup>: 1602,  
Departed this life; in his Mansion-  
house, called Blakmansbery, alias  
Bredge Place: on Sunday morning,  
torn a clock, November y<sup>e</sup> 13<sup>th</sup>: Anno,
