BRIDGE  
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FOOTPATHS.

- 1). From Main Canterbury-Dover Road near West's Shop, in a N.E. direction to Parish Boundary. *Butchers*
- 2). From Main Canterbury-Dover Road, near Lodge-Gate, in a Southerly direction via Bourne Park to Parish Boundary.
- 3). From Brewery Lane, via Long-Meadows, Kingsley Lane and Hop Gardens to Parish Boundary.
- 4). From Kingsley Lane, near Flint Cottages, in a Westerly direction to Middle Pett Farm on Pett Bottom Road.
- 5). From ~~Whitehill Cottages~~ *demolished*, via Pett Bottom Road, Little Pett Farm, Gorsley Wood, Avenue Wood to Parish Boundary.
- 6). From Windmill, via Railway Bridge, "Butts", No.4, Little Pett Farm to Junction with No.5.
- 7). From No.6. at Railway Bridge via the "Butts" and No.4. to Junction with No.5.
- 8). From No.3. in a Westerly direction to Junction with No.6.
- 9). From Windmill, via Great Pett Farm, to Junction of Pett Bottom Road and Heppington Road.
- 10). From Heppington Road at Whitehill Woods in a N.W. direction to Parish Boundary.
- 11). From Pett Bottom Road at Middle Pett Farm in a N.W. direction ~~through~~ Whitehill Woods to Junction with Bridal Road No.4.
- 12). From Pett Bottom Road at Little Eaton Farm in a Southerly direction via Gorsley Wood to Parish Boundary.
- 13). From Pett Bottom Road at Sunnyside Farm Cottage in an Easterly direction to Junction with No.12.
- 14). From Pett Bottom Road at "Woodmans Arms" and the "Black Duck" in an Easterly direction to Junction with No.12.

BRIDGE.  
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BRIDLE ROADS.

- 1). Bridle Road known as "Laundry Lane", from <sup>Now Comyngham Rd.</sup> Mummery's Yard via <sup>Council Paper Dept</sup> Laundry Wood to Parish Boundary.
- 2). From Cross Roads on Canterbury Hill in an Easterly direction to Parish Boundary, continuation to Laundry Lane Bridle Road.
- 3). Bridle Road known as "Lovers Walk", from Canterbury-Dover Main Road via Bridgehill House Drive, along Parish Boundary for a distance of approximately 400 L.Yards.
- 4). Bridle Road, continuation of Renville Lane, via Heppington Road and Whitehill Woods, in a Southerly direction to Parish Boundary.
