There is a biography of Sir Horace Mann Bt in the Dictionary of National Biography. A friend of Horace Walpole, he was the British envoy at Florence.

I recall undertaking some research on him and his family, but my notes are still in store. I think he rented Bourne Park for a number of years. Many of the family papers are deposited at the Kent Record Office at Maidstone (Cornwallis (Mann) MSS - Linton Park Estate - Ref. U24); the family were, inter alia, related to the Baker family, owners of the Sissinghurst Estate and Sissinghurst Castle.
