Vicar of Harford in Huntingdon in 1880 & the  
Vicar at Harford kindly sent to me photos  
of the stained glass window in Harford  
which given by my Gr Grandfather in memory  
of his son Francis Trevelyan who drowned  
there. My aunt's were thrilled with the photos.

The Dickinsons once owned The Estate  
at Bamburgh, & lived at Bamburgh Castle  
Northumberland. They were naval officers.

I understand the Conyngham family  
(1st Marquess) are buried in the family vault
