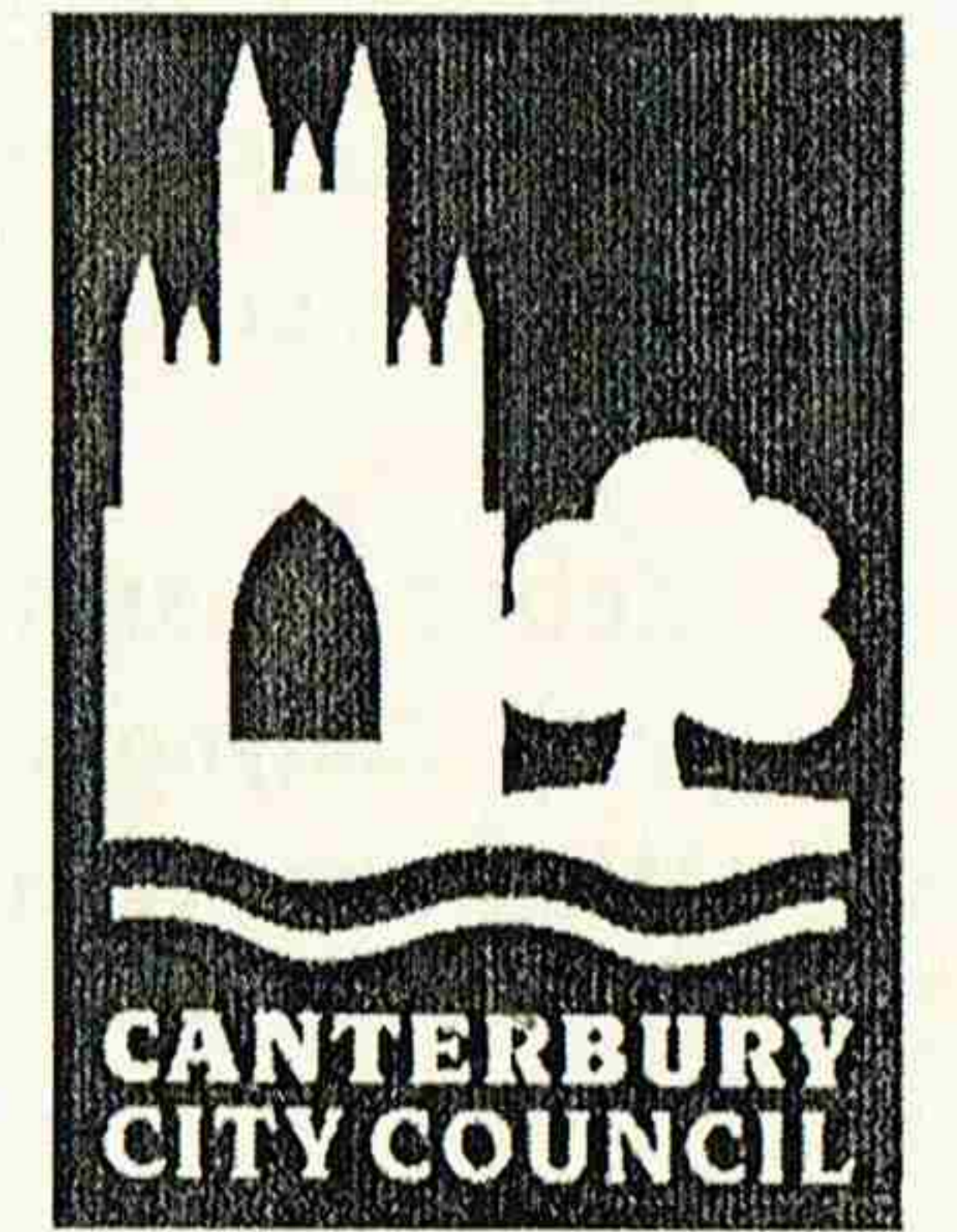

# Bridge Traffic Calming Proposals



## Background

Bridge Parish Council and Canterbury City Council met last December to discuss the details of the village traffic plan. The proposals on the plan were then agreed by the City Council's Highways Sub Committee in February.

## Problem

Two problems were identified as being the most serious:

The speed of traffic approaching the village centre from the north and the lack of pedestrian crossing facilities in the centre of the village, particularly at school times.

## Proposals

To address the problems of speeding traffic, it is proposed to extend the 30mph speed limit and to construct kerb extensions on the south bound side of the road.

Zebra crossings are proposed near to the junction with Conyngham Lane and near to the junction with Western Avenue.
