I am enclosing  
two photographs of the  
'William Nash' clock I  
mentioned in my correspondence  
with you in June.

I am afraid I misled you  
about the 'dating' of the clock.  
The date is not actually  
engraved on the clock but  
was suggested to us by the  
clock maker who put the  
clock into working order when  
we first acquired it. The 1793

date seems appropriate.

I have found the entry for  
William Nash's burial in the  
Bridge parish records, dated as  
8th December 1794.

There were other Nash burials but  
I haven't linked them together.
