The new bridge over the Stour is a neat structure. The ancient mansion, called Bridge Place, the property of the Rev. Edward Taylor, is now occupied by Mr Hardy. Formerly the famous society of noblemen & gentlemen, distinguished by the appellation of Jacobites, was held at the same house.
