leased to G. Gypps M.P. connected  
by marriage to Roberts family  
(J Roberts bought Hall Place in 1700ca)

George Gypps b. 1728

Apothecary, but married 1755

Elizabeth Johanna d. of John Roberts.

GG became speculator in Hops,  
entered parliament for Cantelbury  
(2 MPs) in 1780 & in 1789 became  
senior partner in bankers

Gypps Simonds & Gypps (on site of  
Hoyds today, corner of St-Margaret's sq.  
Elizabeth † 1775, no children, then

m. Sara Stanton: 2 sons,

George M.P. for Ripon & Henry,  
whose sons Henry Plumtree also  
entered parliament.

Third wife Elizabeth & then moved to  
Hall Place. Founding partner of  
K&C West. Tablet on S wall of St Nicholas
