Was Always part of Patricks home. Name of Bridge (Doverday)
 - 2 Map = Parish Boundary as before 1984. Lined village. Note Roads, church on the bend. (line of trees not quite natural - Bridge Place)
 - 3 Map: Symonson 1596 1) Road Across River 2) No Bridge??
3) Mill 4) Court hedge mediating Br. Place.
 - 4 Map: Ogilley 1675 The Grayhound
 - 5 Map: Andrews Drury Herbert 1764 Bifrons = laundry lane. Union Lane. Bridge = water splash. Bridge Place. No Mill or road. Pett Farm. Stacks?
Dots to show that it is paved. Road to Bifrons across Hill
