Jan 21 1793 Louis Executed

Jan 25th -- the inhabitants of the parish of Bishopstone met together, to express their loyalty & firm attachment to His Majesty King George, & the present happy Constitution of this country. They paraded through the village, attended by a band of music, to a wooden pile erected on Barham Downs, for the burning the effigy of Tom Paine, when a most excellent declaration was delivered by John Foote Esq, of Charlton House. who gave very fine fat sheep etc, on the occasion & with most liberal subscription from the Rev. Dr Fo... & other of the Gentlemen in the parish, a plentiful supper was provided at Bridge Hill House, where the company adjourned to & spent the remainder of the evening with the greatest harmony & good humor. Many loyal & constitutional toasts were given, with several songs properly adapted to the occasion.
