1759 Detailed account of working the parish boundary with St Pauls. [Hode farm / Gutteridge]

- Bottom of ye Hill called Stickfarb Hill that leads to the city. - comes after Gutteridge Bottom

1764 the heirs of the Rev Dr. Taylor for Bifrons

1764 Ed Taylor vicar - 1779 last.

1770 Ignatius Geoghegan Esq. for a new house & land at Heylan (previously only Heylan). Hyam "Hyam Hall"

1774 Jan Hallett at Hyam Hall.

1780 John Kirby Curate Wm Howdell Curate

1783 Antony Egerton Hammond Curate.

1785 John Fagg curate

1788 Bifrons back with E. Taylor.

for land belonging to Bridge Hill
