A RESTAURANT'S reputation depends largely on the quality of the staff, and at Skippers you would be hard pressed to find fault with their friendly and attentive manner.

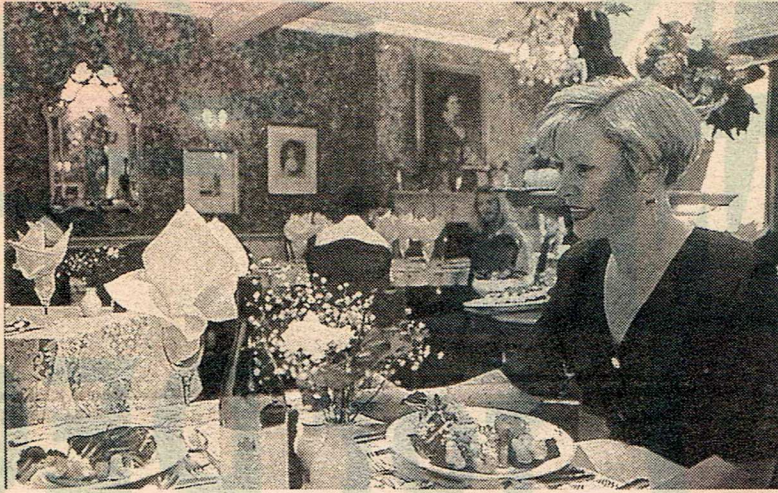
The aim at Skippers is to create a private dinner party, and you cannot help but feel the staff are genuinely pleased to see you.
