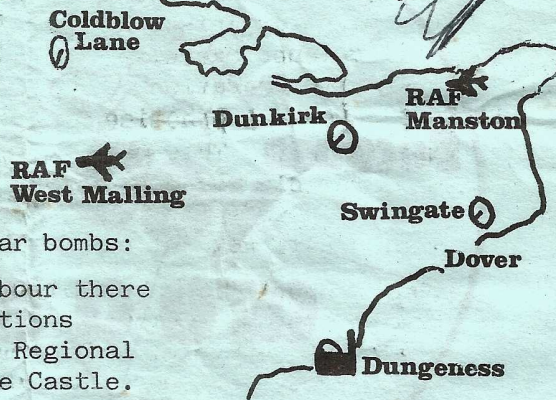

# TARGET: EAST KENT

In September 1980 the Government organised a civil defence exercise code-named Operation Square Leg - a practice nuclear war. This map shows the places in East Kent which were the predicted targets of nuclear bombs:



**Dover** - apart from the harbour there is also the U.S. communications station at Swingate, and a Regional Seat of Government under the Castle.

**Manston** - the military airfield.

**Dungeness** - a likely target because an attack on a nuclear power station would produce massive radio-active fallout. The shaded area on the map shows how far the fallout would have carried in the first 3 hours: virtually the whole of East Kent would be contaminated.

There are other potential targets. The nearest to Canterbury is the communications station at **Dunkirk** - part of a vital U.S. network which links Swingate and Coldblow Lane (between Maidstone and Sittingbourne) with airfields such as Upper Heyford, Alconbury, Mildenhall and Lakenheath where American nuclear bombers are based.

## NOWHERE IN EAST KENT IS SAFE

The presence in this country of so many bases, British and American, means that we would inevitably be drawn into any nuclear war between America and Russia. And we in Kent have our full share of nuclear targets on our doorstep.
