

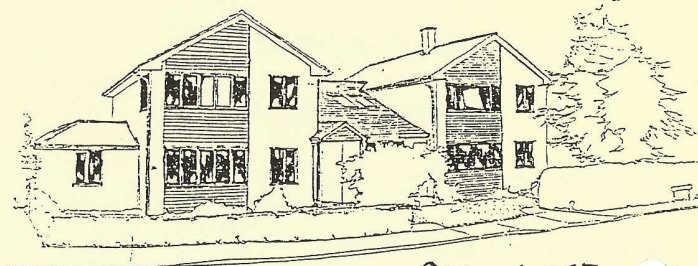
Saxon Lodge has 16 single rooms (some en suite) and two double rooms — all are tastefully decorated with a high degree of comfort as standard.

Saxon Lodge is a family run Residential Home providing a comfortable and welcoming home for the elderly. It is situated in the quiet and well-appointed village of Bridge, only a few miles from Canterbury city centre. The home has recently been extended and refurbished to a high standard. Saxon Lodge offers spacious accommodation in single or double rooms, some with en suite facilities. All rooms have colour television and telephone points.



Saxon Lodge is designed over two floors, all the corridors are wide and we have an eight person lift enabling us to provide accommodation to residents with wheelchairs or walking aids. Full toilet facilities for the ambulant and non-ambulant are available on both the ground and first floors.

Residents are cared for by dedicated and friendly staff 24 hours a day. The proprietors aim to provide a high standard of care and support without encroaching on the individual's right to privacy or choice. All residents have individual care plans.
