# This is the last Will and Testament

of me Charlotte Green of Dringford in the County of Bedfordshire a  
mao and published this 20<sup>th</sup> day of July one thousand eight hundred and  
fifty seven in manner following I will and direct the payment of my just &  
true funeral and testamentary expenses to be made by my Executors and Exors  
trusts hereafter - after payment with all possible speed after my decease & give and  
bequeath my part or share in the messuages or dwelling houses and premises at  
Dringford aforesaid lately purchased by me and all other my real estate if  
any / unto my Executor Charles Green and my two sisters Sarah Green and  
Ann Green and their heirs and assigns as tenants in common and not as joint  
tenants I give and bequeath unto my said brother Charles Green the Legacy  
or sum of Twenty five pounds and unto my nephew and niece Charles Gaffney  
Charlotte Gaffney and Susan Gaffney the Legacy or sum of Ten pounds and  
as several parts of my affection and unto my Executor in Law John Anderson  
Trustee of Dringford I give the sum of Sixty pounds and as to my remaining apparel  
and clothes and the rest and remainder of my personal property to be  
divided in the funds or otherwise I give and bequeath the same unto my three  
sisters Mary Gaffney Sarah Green and Ann Green in equal shares and in  
proportions and lastly I nominate and appoint my said Executor and Execs  
Charles Green and Ann Green joint Executors and Administrators of this my  
last Will hereby revoking all former ones by me at any time heretofore made  
in witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my own  
hand and year first above written - Charlotte Green (S) - Signed  
and sealed published and declared by the said Testatrix Charlotte Green in a

pounds to be paid her at the expiration of twelve calendar months from a  
and after my decease I give devise and bequeath unto John Dobbin of the  
parish of St Paul in the County of Downordt Farmer and William Allan of Duggle  
Street afore said Farmer all that my Copyhold estate lands and premises a  
nelloe Part of the lands under the tenures of Robbin and Flintford or most  
than and also all that Policy of Insurance on the life of Anne Parrott and  
the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds thereon accrued and also all my  
love and dear furniture that my household goods and chattels my jewels  
and ornaments for my own use and all the residue of my estate and effects  
real personal and mixed whatsoever to hold the same unto the said John &  
Dobbin and William Allan their heirs Executors Administrators  
and assigns upon the trusts following namely upon trust that the  
said John Dobbin and William Allan and the survivors of them  
and the heirs Executors and Administrators of such survivor / or either  
after the said my trustees or trustee / do and shall receive and receive  
my said Copyhold estate and also distribute and give all other  
my trust estate in such and several parts as they shall think fit  
and the said John Dobbin and my Daughter Mary Greenland & her heirs  
share alike as tenants in common and for the more easy execution of  
my said estate and effects in case my said son and Daughter should disagree  
in such division between themselves & each other or my said trustees or  
trustee to make sale and absolutely dispose of my said estate and effects or  
such parts thereof as are in its nature saleable either by Public Auction or  
private contract and to pay assign receive or otherwise receive the  
same to the said John Dobbin and to such other persons as they shall think fit  
and from such sale and other purposes thereof and of all other my money  
upon trust to pay and give the same unto and equally between my  
said son and Daughter James and Mary Greenland and to share alike  
the receipts of my said trustees or trustee shall be sufficient discharge  
for all monies thereon expressed to be received and the person or per-  
sons paying the same shall not be required to see to the application  
thereof or be answerable or accountable for the use application or non-  
application of the same and I hereby declare that all monies payable  
to such of my Daughters as are married women shall be paid into a  
their own respective names in obedience of any such and without  
being subject to his debts control or engagements the receipts alone of  
my said Daughters being sufficient discharge to my said trustees or  
trustee and I hereby nominate and appoint my said son James  
and my said Daughter Mary Executor and Administrators of this my will  
and by revoking all other wills heretofore by me in witness whereof  
I the said James Greenland the Elder have hereunto set my hand the  
twentieth day of June one thousand eight hundred and fifty six

as for and to be his last will and testament in the presence of us who  
in his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto set our
