 of Town of the said City of Canterbury Gentleman and Admors of the
 said Sir Charles in the Parish of St. Dunstons in the said County of Kent my
 executors administrators and assigns Upon trust to receive
 and get in my real estate personal estate and invest the monies to arise
 hereof in the name or name of the trustees or trustee for the time
 being of my Will on Government or real securities in England And upon
 further trust to permit and empower my said wife to receive the annual
 income of the said money or the securities whereon the same shall be
 invested during her life and after her decease Upon trust out of the same
