sum & after the payment of these said several sums of Money I will
pay & divide the Residue & Remainder of the produce of my said
Realty & Personal Estates into 4 amongst the said
Charles Burford Catharine Burford Thomas Howard & my son
Charles Burford & I do hereby constitute & appoint the said
George Bowfield & John Burdett Executors of this my last Will
& Testament & that it shall & may be lawful for them my said
Heirs & Admin of them to sell or lease of their lands & tenements in the first place
by & out of the proceeds to be had & to be received thereunto respectively all
such debts & charges & expenses as they or either of them
shall think proper or be put unto for or by recovery of the
performance of this my Will or for any other thing in them reported
or to be managed or execution respectively or any thing in any
