pounds and to my Son Amos Bardwell the sum of five
pounds each also I do hereby give and bequeath to my Daughter
of the said Dorothy Bardwell the sum of forty pounds to Martha Wood
the sum of thirty pounds to Edward Will son of Edward Will my
Godson the sum of ten pounds to Susan the wife of Robert Cutting to Robert
Ditton and to the said Peter Bramble the sum of twenty pounds each
to William Will and Susan Will the sum of ten pounds each and
to George Ditton and Ann Tharia Ditton son and daughter of the
said Robert Ditton the sum of ten pounds each all to be paid before
my decease and to be paid within six Calendar months
next after my decease and I do hereby desire and command to present

said Tharia my Daughter and my Son to wit Peter Bramble
to my Daughter Ann and to my Daughter Susan
to my Son Edward and to my Son Robert with their signatures belonging

my Will and shall a dozen Oaths to the said Martha Wood each as
many small things as will suffice to a Room comfortably and
I give my Chamber to the said Ann Will also I give my said
Daughter to the said Martha Wood some part of my linen and
Clothing apparel and to dispose of the remaind^r as she shall think
prop^r and all the Remain^r of my Estate and Effects whatsoever if any
of the payment of my debts legall spiritual and testamentary debts
I give and bequeath unto and amongst the several persons to whom
legals are given by this my will in witness whereof I have written
at my own hand and seal the day and year first above written Susanna Bardwell X
