thereof I give devise and bequeath all the rest residue and remainder of
my Estate and Effects on what tenure or of what year or term or terminability
or nature or real power the same are or may be less or more than half real as
personal and whatsoever the same are or may be divided into my said Estate
shares to take the same and every part thereof to my said heirs wife Sarah their
heirs executors administrators and assigns to and for their and their issue proper uses
and benefit during all my present and future time and estate and according to the
nature and quality of my said Estate and Interest therein and I do hereby name
constitute and appoint my said wife Sarah Robert Rose of the City of State aforesaid
Bargemaster and William Henry Eastwick Senior of Liverpool in the County of Lancashire
Executive and EXECUTORS of this my Will But it is nevertheless
in my will and doth hereby request my Committee and Executors not to join in account
of my District of and in a certain floodgate State called the Braan a high living and
being near the Town of Braan in the County of Lancashire under the direction and
management of John Corcoran Esquire the acting Examiner upon the Will of my late
father Thomas Jorden unless my original share in the said State and residue were
soe some years since by my Assignees to the said John Corcoran or some part of
my family for the sum of twenty pounds is restated to my said Committee or in
Committee our repayment of the said sum of twenty pounds with lawful interest and
charges here the sum of date and it is my Will and doth further direct that my said
said Committee Robert Rose and William Henry Eastwick shall remunerate themselves
all Expenses out of my Estate and Effects and that they shall be respectively in no
accountable only for their own respective acts and costs due heretofore
and make void all former and other wills and Wills by me at any time heretofore
made and declare this and this alone to be my last Will and Testament the witness
whereof the said Thomas Jorden have countersigned this day and affixed my
seal the tenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and

I Sarah Irons of the Parish of Aldeburgh in the County of Suffolk
being in good health and of sound mind memory and understanding doke as
follows That is to say first and principally remouement my soul to God as
who gave it and will bothe to commit to the Earth to be decently interred at the

as God of the Goodness heare bestowed upon me I give devise and bequeath the
same as follows That is to say I give devise and bequeath unto my Brother

bale or barrel of ffreelode sheep Cashter or Lamb containing one and more or less
sheated and rising at Overlands in the Parish of Bungay under Blean and
also all the Stock and Crop upon it Also four hundred pounds in the forme for me
rent and all my just debts funeral expences the charges of proving and executing
it this my last Will shall have full paye All the rest of my personal property
thousand ffrument goods Cattle effects debts due and owing to me knowne or unknowne
for money and all other my personal Estate whatsoever and wheresoever and of
what kind and nature soever the same may be unto my said brother William
Elw before named his heirs or assigns for ever And lastly I doe nominate
entitile and appoint my self Collegate of the Parish of Aldeburgh in the County of
Suffolk alias Elw Executor to this my last Will and Testament thereby in
witness and making now all and every other Will or Wills at any time done
by me made and do declare this to be my last Will and Testament and for me
the trouble of executing this my Will and Testament give devise and bequeath
to the aforesaid ffreelode Collegate five pounds in lawfull money the which we
will of ffreelode Colgate set my lands and real estate worth yente say of one
thousand one thousand eight hundred and thirty shillings and six pence
paid overlands and published by the above named Sarah Irons as and for the
last Will and Testament in the presence of us who at this request and in their
presence and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as in
witnesses unto Richd Bromley & Ann Challcraft, James
Idams.
