 always and I do hereby declare that in case any or either of them my said Children shall
 depart this life before he she or they shall respectively attain the age of twenty one
 years and without leaving lawful issue as aforesaid then I will and direct the share or
 shares of him her or them to be paid without lawful issue as aforesaid shall go and come
 to the survivors and survivor or other or others of them my said Children and to be a
 equally divided between and amongst them share and share alike and to be paid to them
 also as and when they shall respectively attain the age of twenty one years and my Will
 further is that it shall be lawful for the said Doctor Hall and Stabial shall or the survivor
 of them his Executors or Assignors at their or his discretion to advance at any time or times
 any sum not exceeding sixty pounds in part of the presumptive share or shares for the
 time being of any of my Children for the purpose of placing out him her or them to learn
 any trade or business or for his her or their preferment establishment or advancement in
 the world notwithstanding such respective shares shall not then have become due or
 payable and I nominate and appoint my said Wife Elizabeth of my said Children a
 during their minority and my said Doctor Hall and Stabial shall Executors
 and Trustees of this my Will and I do hereby will and declare that they my said Executors
 Trustees and each of them their and each of their Executors and Assignors shall be
 released and discharged fully with and for full and perfect value of the said trust moneys
 and profits as they shall respectively actually receive and that the due of them shall
 not be answerable or accountable for the loss of them or for the any books receipts notes
 or drafts of the share of them but each of them for his own any books receipts notes
 or drafts only nor shall they or any of them be answerable or accountable for any as
 Doctor Doctor or other person with whom or in whose hands all or any part of
 the said trust moneys may be deposited or lodged for safe custody or otherwise in the
 execution of the said trust nor for the insufficiency or deficiency of any stocks funds or
 securities in or upon which any of the said trust moneys may be placed out or invested in
 pursuance of and in conformity to this my Will nor for any other misfortune loss
 damage or other thing may happen in the execution of the aforesaid trust or in relation
 thereto unless the same shall happen by or through their own wilful neglect or a
 default respectively and also that they my said Executors and Trustees and each of them
 their and each of their Executors and Assignors shall and may by with and out of the
 moneys which shall come to them respective shares by virtue of the trusts aforesaid
 obtain to and reimburse themselves and himself respectively all costs charges and
 expenses which they or any or either of them may respectively sustain or pay or be
 put into in or about the execution of the trusts aforesaid or in answer relating
 thereto as well as a reasonable compensation for his and their loss of time and trouble
 in the execution thereof and lastly I do hereby revoke and make void all former and other
 Wills by me at any time heretofore made and declare this only to be and contain my
 last Will and Testament in witness whereof I the said Thomas Hall have to this my last
 Will and Testament contained in this and the two preceding sheets set my hand and seal
 the sixth day of August one thousand eight hundred and twenty one

following that is to say first I direct that all and every my just debts funeral expences
 and the charges of proving and carrying this my Will be fully paid and satisfied out of
 my monies or securities for money or other my Personal Estate also I give bequeath and
 bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth and to my son James Ratliff and James a
 Butcherworth of Davison Street Bethley Square in the County of Middlesex Executors
 all and every my Discreetors Lands Tenements and heretofore purchased and others of a
 Discreetors Lands Tenements and heretofore and the residue and remainder of my monies &
 securities for money my several household furniture Plate Silver China and all other my property
 goods chattels estate and effects whatsoever and whosoever that shall or may be sold
 disposed or interposed in or out of the name of my bequest to hold all the same
 unto them my said Wife Elizabeth and to the said James Ratliff and James Butcherworth
 and to their heirs executors and assigns indifferently upon the trusts and to and for the
 several uses intents and purposes hereinafter mentioned before and contained of and
 containing the same that is to say Upon trust that they my said Executors James Ratliff
 and James Butcherworth and the survivors of them his executors and assigns shall and do
 permit and suffer my said Wife Elizabeth to have use and enjoy such part of my said above
 sold furniture Plate Silver and China as she may request or desire and to have the use &
 occupation of such part of my said Discreetors or Tenements and Appurtenances as she
 shall think proper without paying any Rent or other compensation to my said other trusts
 for the same furniture and Discreetors or Tenements and also my said Wife not committing
 or suffering any willful waste spoil or destruction thereto or to any part thereof and also
 upon trust that they my said Wife and the said James Ratliff and James Butcherworth
 and the survivors and survivors of them and the said executors and assigns if such
 survivors shall and do at such time and times as they shall think proper and in such
 way and manner as they shall seem most for the benefit and advantage of my said Estate
 sell and dispose of all and every my said Discreetors Lands Tenements and heretofore
 purchased and others of Discreetors Lands Tenements and heretofore household furniture Plate
 Silver China and all other my said Property Estate and Effects whatsoever and whosoever
 moves or not consisting of monies or securities for money for the most money and best price
 and price that can at the time of the sale and respective sales thereof be reasonably
 had or gotten for the same and upon trust to place out and invest the monies arising
 by the means aforesaid or otherwise coming to the hands of my said Executors or either of
 them under and by virtue of this my Will upon Government or such other good and
 sufficient security or securities at Interest and from time to time to alter vary the
 security and securities upon which the same may have been placed out or invested as
 they my said Executors and the survivors and survivors of them his or her executors or
 assigns shall think proper and also to withdraw invested in Government security or
 securities such sum and sums of money as shall appear to be therein at the time
 of my bequest or to alter and vary such security or securities if they my said Executors or
 shall think proper and in the mean time until my said Discreetors Lands Tenements
 and heretofore shall be sold and disposed of pursuant to the power herebefore given
 for that purpose upon trust to let and live the same to such Tenant and Tenants and
 for such Rent and Rents way and manner as to them my said Executors shall seem
 most and upon further trust that they my said Executors and the survivors and a
 survivor of them the said executors or assigns of such survivors shall and do pay and
 apply or otherwise permit and suffer for my said Wife Elizabeth and for assigns to her
 receive and take to & for her and their own proper use and benefit for and during the
 term of her natural life the Interest Dividends and Profits of all and every my monies
 and securities for money and of the monies to be invested as aforesaid together with the
 Rent Issues and Profits of my said Discreetors Lands Tenements and heretofore until the
 sale and disposal thereof as aforesaid directed and from and immediately after the
 bequest of my said Wife then upon trust that they my said Executors and the survivors
 and survivors of them and the executors and assigns of such survivors shall and do a
 continue invested in Government or such other good and sufficient security or a
 securities as aforesaid or otherwise that and invest therein such sum and sums of
 money as will produce a clear annual sum of four hundred pounds upon trust to
