 mynne lymman term pomydes to be payed also before the feaste of our lord god next I am I give
 Elizabeth Abonett widow at Reding five pomydes to be payed before the same feaste
 Item I give to Gylthorpe wylke hedele of the Remourse hall twentie shillinges And as
 touching the disposition of all mynne landes tenementes and hereditamentes as I have
 wherof I am lorden at all places in the Reame of England I will give and dispose the same
 in forme ensuynge that is to saye first I give and bequeath to the person and churchwardens
 of all parishes wherof I am lorden and to therr successors forever to the use of the poore in the
 same parishes one yearly Annuitie of twentie shillinges assuynge and gentyng out of mynne
 landes and hereditamentes in the same parishes to be payed yearly at the feaste of our
 lord god And for mynne payment thereof the same person and churchwardens and therr
 successors to distraine ad in case of non payment Item I give and bequeath to the
 Abbe and monach brethren and sisters of the Priory of St Peter of London and to therr
 successors forever one yearly Annuitie of one shillinge of lawful money of England
 to be assuynge and gentyng out of all mynne landes tenementes and hereditamentes in
 the parishes of all the parishes wherof I am lorden and to be payed at some tyme or feaste
 in the year that is to saye at the feaste of the nativite of St John Baptist or at the feaste of
 Michael the Archangel the feaste of our lord god and the Annuntion of the virgin marie or in
 an and twentie dayes next after eveyr of the same feastes by even portions And for
 mynne payment of the same Annuitie or any parte thereof the sayed Abbe and monach
 brethren and sisters and therr successors from tyme to tyme to distraine ad in case of
 non payment Item I further give and bequeath to the sayed Abbe and monach
 brethren and sisters and to therr successors forever one other Annuitie of fortie
 shillinges to be yearly assuynge out of mynne sayed landes and tenementes in the
 parishes of the feaste of the birth of our lord god and Easter by them to be bestowed
 on the poore persons in Reding and Redwate and I will them self the feaste yearly
 payed out of mynne sayed landes at the sayed feastes two shillinges to the sayed Abbe
 and monach of the sayed company the yearly attendaunce on them for therr paymte to be
 taken in the distribution of the sayed yearly summe of forty shillinges and for mynne
 payment thereof or any parte of the sayed summe by the feaste to be had or taken at
 the feaste of the birth of our lord god and Easter I make and ordaine that mynne wife mynne
 daughter and I bidayne and appoynt mynne trustie frendes Richard Hynton Remourse
 and John Godsell Maxwelle and give and bequeath to each of them for therr paymte
 to assist mynne sayed wife five pomydes And for the rest of mynne summe I referre
 to the discretion of mynne sayed executours In witness wherof I have hereunto
 put mynne hand and seale the daye and year above sayed John Benett
 Sealed and delivered for his last will in presence of Jo. Thompson Sec.
 et mei Pm. Boyer. John Godsell. Richard Hynton. John Benett.
