 wales. Item I give unto my daughter william Dore, my doublet of red silk, two pair
 of hute waddes, luffe, two pair of black luffe that I use to wear, my gorone of
 blene cloth, furred, my blacke cloth cappe for the day, my night cappe of cloth,
 my old blacke gowne furred with blacke and my boote Item I give to my daughter
 Margarett blacke point of waterfurre and Budget one fume or quarter of red silk. Item
 I give to her for my night mydden blanket a cace of the best croymade, two
 booke, and two sheetes of red silk or clere furre. I will in money at the discretion
 of my executor, Item I give to Clemente my shute fute and two shute shillinge a right
 shute to be paid yearly in one year next after my deathe, that is to saye four shillinge
 eight pence quarterly till it be paid. Item I give to Robert, plougher, bond, a horse
 cappe, a newe red, two pair of newe best newe shute, and two pair of newe
 furre, and two shillinge in money immediately after my deathe. And I will that
 my executor shall pay to the same Robert for the shillinge next within four year
 after my deathe. Item I give to my said daughter, Item I give to my daughter
 Margarett my shute, my blacke cloth gowne furred with blacke, my shute of blacke
 cloth furred with felle, my doublet of blacke cloth. Item I will that my
 childrens portions after said shute declared by my executor unto my said
 daughter shall be the fourth part of it, to be paid with sufficient furre to
 my executor and to her discretion aswell to deliver the said portions and every
 of them in forme here before declared at all of the curche of the church, to pay for the
 curche and fiddinge of John my sonne in such sort as he is more like or
 better at the discretion of my executor. And wherof here before I have appointed
 to my said daughter for her life the thirteenth part of all my furniture of household
 at her age as it is now, what soever it is, and after her deathe the said to be to my
 said daughter John without any willfull purveyance or impleminte of any part thereof
 my will and meaning is that she shall not have the same except she be found
 my executor by such furre as in such sort as he is more like or better at the
 discretion and purveyance of the said executor and furniture according to my executor
 appointment. Item I bequeath to my daughter Margarett my shute fute
 for shillinge eight pence. Item I will that my executor do shute for my deathe
 as they may be possible, and as out in an other have hope of appointment of shute after
 his deathe, with this purpose to committe his friends and executor to pay to him
 four shillinge yearly within the year of his deathe in the county of wylshyre
 and to the executor of the shute of wylshyre three shute shillinge. Item I bequeath
 to my daughter Margarett my shute fute and two shute shillinge eight pence to be paid
 yearly two year next after my deathe, till it be paid the first year without shillinge
 four pence, the second year without shillinge four pence. The residue of all my
 goods and chattels not bequeathed, my debt and legacies paid and delivered furre
 to be paid by my executor upon his appointment of my sonne Edward at Bristol.
 And of the residue of my said shute fute will I bequeath unto my lovinge friend
 Master Gillebert of Cantuarie and his successors of wylshyre for without
 charge unto my executor, desiringe them to take the trouble hereof upon them
 for the good will which I have in them towards me, and for their paines I give
 to each of them, xli.

This is the laste wille and Testamente of

the said Henry Courtenay of my lands and tenures made the day and year above
 said. That is to saye, I will that all best lands tenures and hereditages
 to me bequeathed by the laste wille and Testament of my father John Courtenay
 gentelman, after the deathe of my mother shall remaine and differre according to
 the contentacion of the said wille and to my landes and tenures in wylshyre
 and Budget whiche I purchased of divers persons after the laste deathe of my father
