sisters Mary, Ann, Sarah, and Harriott Garner in equal shares  
as Tenants in common and not as joint Tenants and to their respective  
Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns respectively according to  
the nature and quality of the same several Estates And I appoint  
my said sisters Mary and Ann Garner Executrices of this my Will  
And I hereby revoke all my former Wills In witness whereof  
I the said Susannah Garner have to this my last Will and
