INITIAL REVIEW OF COUNTY ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 1. Schedule 9 to the Local Government Act 1972 requires the Local Government Boundary Commission to review the electoral arrangements for each county in England as soon as practicable after the Home Secretary has made the last order to bring into effect the revised electoral arrangements for each district in the county.
- 2. Orders have now been made for all the districts in Kent and the purpose of this letter is to announce the beginning of the review of the county electoral arrangements and to explain the procedure to be followed.

CONSULTATION

- 3. Section 60(1) of the Act requires the Commission to secure that persons who may be interested in the review are informed of the proposals to conduct it. Section 60(2) requires the Commission to consult the council of any local government area affected and such other local authorities and public bodies as appear to them to be concerned and such other persons as they think fit. The Commission must also consult any staff associations who ask to be consulted. Copies of this letter are accordingly being sent to the bodies and persons listed in Annex A. Copies will be supplied on request to any body representative of staff employed by your authority and to any other interested body or person.
- 4. The Commission request the assistance of the County Council in giving publicity to the start of this review. They ask your Council to arrange at the earliest opportunity for publication of a notice in the form in Annex B (suitably completed) for two successive weeks in appropriate local newspapers. As soon as the notice has been published for the second time a cutting of each insertion should be sent to the Commission with a note of the newspaper in which it was published and the date of publication. The cost of these insertions will be reimbursed by the Commission on receipt of the Council's invoice. Your Council are also asked to place a copy of the notice on display at places where public notices are customarily displayed.
