Filling of Casual Vacancies on Parish Councils

As you are no doubt aware prior to 1st January, 1976, if a casual vacancy occurred in the office of Councillor of a Parish, the vacancy was filled by the Parish Council by co-optation. However, the Local Government Act, 1972, brought about a change making provision, in certain circumstances, for elections to be held in respect of all casual vacancies arising after 31st December, 1975.

It occurs to me that not all Parish Councils are familiar with the correct procedure to be followed and the enclosed statement may be helpful to you. I also enclose copies of the form of public notice required to be given of the occurrence of the casual vacancy. Further copies may be obtained upon request.
