BRIDGE
BOWLING CLUB.



Rules

Passed May 7th, 1931.

1. The name of the Club shall be "The Bridge Bowling Club."

2. That any gentleman desirous of becoming a Member of the Club must be proposed and seconded by Members, and elected by a majority of the Committee.

3. That the management of the Club shall be carried on by a Committee of five Members, together with the Officers of the Club, five to form a quorum.

4. That a General Meeting of the Club shall be held at the close of the season, at which the Officers and Committee shall be elected. The Hon. Secretary and Hon. Treasurer to give their reports.

5. That a General Meeting be held during the first week in March in each year.

6. That any Member shall be allowed to introduce a friend, and should he play he must conform to the rules of the Club.

7. Residents of Bridge may not be permitted to play as "Friends" on more than two occasions.

8. The Committee shall have power to suspend or expel any Member who shall wilfully infringe any of the rules of the Club, or whose conduct on the green or adjoining property shall, in the opinion of the Committee, be prejudicial to the interests of the Club.

9. That no new rule be made, or any rule altered, rescinded or cancelled without written notice of motion to the Hon. Secretary, who shall then call a General Meeting of the Club,

when such motion shall be discussed and carried, or otherwise.

10. A General Meeting of the Club can be called on a requisition signed by five Members, to be forwarded to the Hon. Secretary seven days before such meeting.

11. The Annual Subscription to the Club shall be payable within two months of the opening of the green each year.

12. All woods used in Matches or Handicaps must be of the standard pattern, and stamped by the E.B.A.

13. Any Members failing to meet their opponents in a Match or Handicap at a prescribed time, shall forfeit their right to the Match, unless prevented by illness.

14. Should any dispute arise in Matches or Handicaps that the Referee cannot decide upon, he must report same to the Committee, whose decision shall be final.

15. Any Member borrowing Club woods to play away, must return same as soon as possible.

16. No Member shall play two games successively should there be any other Members desirous of playing.

17. All players, when delivering a bowl, must have the front foot on the mat.

18. That all arrangements for Matches and Handicaps shall be in the hands of the Committee.

19. All Members and Visitors must wear black or brown rubber shoes on the green for Match play.

20. Members introducing a friend must pay 4d. per game of 21 up.

21. Onlookers are requested not to pass remarks or otherwise interfere with any game or games in progress.

22. Weekly Membership Tickets for Visitors may be issued at 2/- per week.

23. A book shall be kept on the premises of the Club, in which any Member introducing a friend must sign his name and that of the friend whom he introduces, and must see that the Club dues are paid.
