THE LONDON-CANTERBURY-
DOVER TRUNK ROAD
(BRIDGE BY-PASS SIDE
ROADS) ORDER 197

THE SECRETARY OF
STATE FOR THE ENVIRON-
MENT hereby gives notice that
he proposes to make the follow-
ing Orders:

1. an Order under section 7 of
the Highways Act 1959
providing:
 - (a) that a road which he
proposes to construct
at Bridge in the
County of Kent shall
become a trunk road as
from the date when the
Order comes into
operation, and
 - (b) that the length of the
London - Canter-
bury - Dover Trunk
Road to be superseded
shall cease to be a
trunk road as from the
date on which notice is
given by him to the
County Council of Kent
(who will become the
highway authority res-
ponsible for that
length) that the new
trunk road is open for
through traffic, and
2. an Order under section 9 of
the Highways Act 1959
authorising him:
 - (a) to improve, raise,
lower or otherwise alter
highways,
 - (b) to stop up highways,
 - (c) to construct new high-
ways,
 - (d) to stop up private
means of access to
premises, and
 - (e) to provide new means
of access to premises,
all at Bridge aforesaid, and
providing for the transfer
of each of the said new
highways to the County
Council of Kent as from
the date on which he noti-
fies the Council that the
new highways have been
completed and are open for
through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and
of the relevant plans may be in-
spected free of charge at all
reasonable hours from 10
November 1972 to 22 December
1972 at the Department of the
Environment, 2 Marsham Street,
London SW1P 3EB, and at the
offices of the Regional Control-
ler (Roads and Transportation),
South Eastern, "Edgeborough,"
Epsom Road, Guildford, Surrey,
the Kent County Council,
County Hall, Maidstone, Kent,
the Bridge-Blean Rural District
Council, Council Offices, 41 Old
Dover Road, Canterbury, and at
the Post Office, Bridge, Canter-
bury, Kent.

ANY PERSON may not later
than 22 December 1972 object to
the making of the Orders, by
notice to the Secretary of State,
at his address at the office of
the Regional Controller (Roads
and Transportation) South East-
ern, quoting reference DSE
200/09/TR 34/T 020 and stating
the grounds of objection.
