



Princess Alice buried at Frogmore

THE coffin of Princess Alice, Countess of Athlone, being followed by her only surviving child, Lady May Abel Smith, and her husband, Col Sir Henry Abel Smith, at the funeral service yesterday at St George's Chapel, Windsor, of the last survivor of Queen Victoria's 37 grandchildren, who died on Saturday aged 97. Behind them are the Queen, Prince Philip and Queen

Elizabeth the Queen Mother, who flew to Windsor from Sandringham where they are on holiday.

The mourners included the Kings of Norway and Sweden, Princess Juliana of the Netherlands, Princess Alice's secretary, Miss Mary Goldie, and the six nurses who cared for her until her death.
