METAL FATIGUE IS MAIN PROBLEM

AIR BOARD'S CONCERN

Metal fatigue has been the Air Registration Board's outstanding problem in the past few years, Mr. R. E. Hardingham, secretary of the board, said last night. Recent evidence stressed the need for full-scale testing of structures, whatever the cost.

The board is responsible for the issue of airworthiness certificates on civil aircraft. Mr. Hardingham was speaking to the Insurance Institute of London on "Safety in the Air."

With the revival of civil aviation after the war, he said, it was realized that the possibility of failure of major components owing to fatigue should be considered. One of the reasons was that post-war aircraft would be expected to have considerably longer lives.
