



Sit-down protest on the A2

VILLAGERS blocking the A2 London-Dover road at Bridge, near Canterbury, yesterday in protest against what they called a "death trap" because of the volume of traffic.

Police diverted all traffic from entering the village and allowed the protesters, who are campaigning for an extension of the M2, to sit down for 10 minutes.

Some of the demonstrators refused to leave and were carried from the road by police. Two were arrested.
