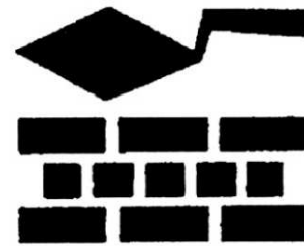

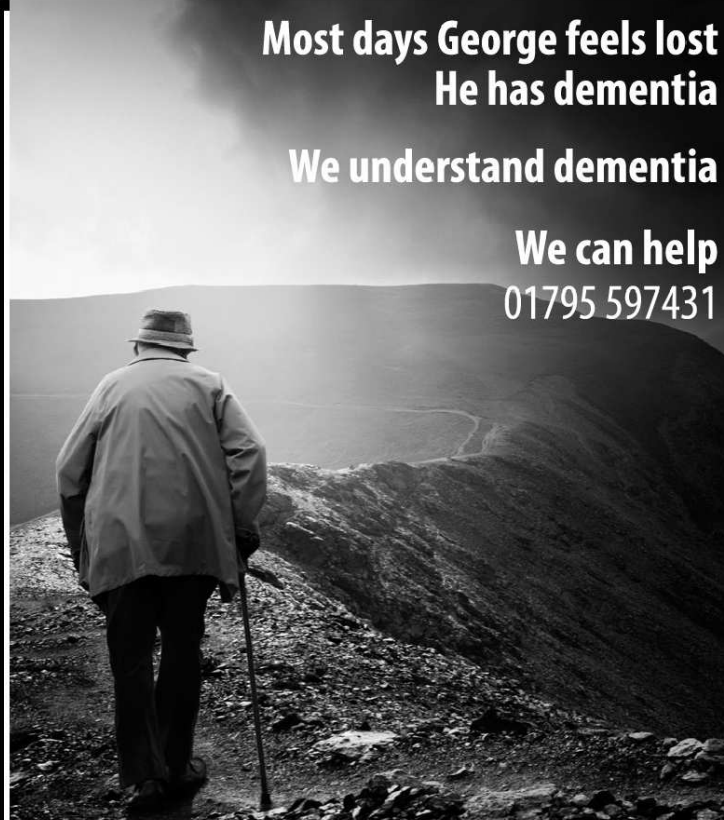

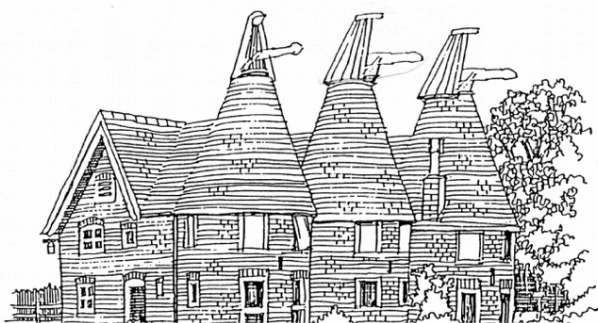

Ian Hobson will be giving a video presentation in Kingston Barn on his attempt to climb Everest from the Chinese side, which is considered to be the most difficult route. Apart from the mountaineering, there is a chance to see the countryside life en-route, and should appeal to non-mountaineers. Completion of Wheel Window Project at St Mary's Patrixbourne.

On Sunday 21st September a Festal Evensong service was held at St Mary's Patrixbourne to give thanksgiving for the completion of the project to restore the Norman Wheel window, in the East wall of the Chancel. The Festal Evensong was led by Canon Jonathan LLOYD, the Preacher was the Dean of Canterbury, the Right Rev Robert Willis DL, and the congregation was joined by a choir of choristers from Canterbury Cathedral, directed by Dr David Flood.

The project to repair the Wheel window also included repairs to the North Valley gutter and much needed redecoration of the chancel. Repairs were necessary on the Wheel window as the beautiful Norman stonework was showing signs of cracking and movement; holes had appeared in the window between the stonework and the glass inserts and the central 'axle' of the wheel was flattened downwards with the glass bowing outwards. The damage had been discovered when scaffolding in place during the restoration of the Swiss glass windows, below the wheel window, in 2010, allowed a close up inspection of this important Norman feature of the church.

The work, which was completed this summer, was funded by generous grants from organisations such as Viridor Environmental Credits, the Friends of Kent Churches and the Matthiesen Trust. The Friends of St Mary's Patrixbourne held concerts and talks to raise funds and generous donations were received from many individual Parishioners. Without such generosity the project would not have been possible.

The work was carried out by skilled craftsmen, and during work on the stained glass, by the Cathedral Stained Glass Studio, a maker's mark and the date 1837 were discovered etched into the glass. This dates the window glass with the same date as the donation of the Swiss glass by the Marchioness of Conyngham, in 1837. It is likely that the brightly coloured glass of the Wheel window was made by the same craftsman, as the one who made the coloured surrounds around the 10 panels of Swiss glass, in the three lancets below.

If you are passing the church, please drop in and view the restored window. The stonework is now clean and structurally sound, with details of the carved head and cat masks clearly revealed. From the inside the glass looks bright and clean, especially so in early morning sunshine which streams directly through the window. A wonderful sight!

Thank you to all who helped this project reach completion.

Produce and plants sold well and lots of books found new homes. Many of the Ride and Stride visitors on Saturday were delighted to stop a little longer than usual to enjoy the festival and several cycled on with pots of jam and flowers in their rucksacks. The weekend came to a final climax with a well-attended Evensong, with singing led by the Bridge Church choir, at which the Vicar preached below a floral aircraft, floating above his head in the pulpit.

ARMISTICE DAY AND THE POPPY APPEAL - HELP NEEDED

Readers may be interested to learn that your current Poppy Appeal Organiser lived in Sarajevo in 1984, 70 years after WWI began, and on several occasions has stood on the pavement block where Gavrilo Princip fired the first shot of that war, killing Archduke Ferdinand.

In the more recent Bosnian war of 20 years ago my student dormitory block which used to house 1500 students in a suburb called Nedzarici, was blown to bits. In a visit after that war I found the plaque giving the street name and number in the ruins and still have it. The block has now been rebuilt and the one opposite, where there used to be a canteen, has become the Bosnian Ministry of Security!

It may also be of interest that at one time we had a very unusual book-keeper at our company: Kemal Pervanic author of "The Killing Days", about his time in a Bosnian concentration camp in 1992. He now spends his time trying to assist in conflict resolution.

These notes have been written with an eye to attracting your attention. This November we are in need of more volunteers to assist with the Poppy Appeal. It does not take up more than a couple of hours to go collecting during the fortnight preceding 11.11.14. Notes from Bridge Parish Council meeting

11th. September 2014

Neighbourhood Plan – Prof Joe Connor reported that the first draft of the Neighbourhood Plan had been collated and was being formatted. It would be printed and distributed to every household in Bridge for comment. There would be an event in the village hall on 1st November at which residents would be invited to discuss the draft.

Bridge Emergency Plan – Cllr Kate Wortham said that an outline plan would be presented to the Parish Council in October. This would be an on-going document subject to amendment as situations changed. The Committee were contacting other services so that plans could be coordinated. A database of vulnerable residents would be compiled and this would be subject to Data Protection Legislation. It was agreed that the current location of the sandbag store was not appropriate. A decision on whether to purchase a new store would be taken at the October meeting. The best location for such a store was under consideration

Community Flood Warden– It was agreed to appoint a Community Flood Warden for Bridge. Richard McCarthy agreed to undertake the role. Others could be co-opted to assist in an emergency. Cllr Sue Hodges thanked Mr McCarthy for taking on the role.

Nailbourne Pollution –Kent County Council were planning to resurface Brewery Lane and Bridgeford Way in the autumn. While this work was going on the City Council would install the mechanism for floodgates at the ford. Non-return valves were being installed in some properties in Patribourne and it was hoped some would be installed in Riverside Close._

Amendment to Standing Orders – It was agreed to amend Standing Orders to comply with the Openness of Local Government Bodies Regulation 2014.

Review of Polling District & Polling Places- Councillors did not wish to recommend any changes either to the polling district or location of the polling station following the electoral boundary changes.

Recreation Ground – Cllr Brigitte Ward reported that the annual safety inspection report had been received. There were no significant risk factors identified. The Recreation Committee would consider whether any of the minor items mentioned in the report needed immediate attention. Cllr Hodges reported that volunteers from the Kentish Stour Countryside Partnership had cleared the area near the top gate. Children from the primary school would be planting 100 plug plants in the next few days.

Recreation Ground Working Party –Volunteers were asked to join the working party on the recreation ground on the morning of Saturday 18th October.

Bridge in Bloom – It was agreed to spend up to £50 on vouchers, flowers and engraving of trophies for 'Bridge in Bloom'. Cllr Hodges thanked Cllr Ann Edmonds and Mrs Vicky White for judging the competition. The presentation of awards would take place in Mansfield Court residents' lounge on 24th. September at 2.30pm.

Planning Committee – Cllr John Hill agreed to sit on the Planning Committee when Cllr Robert Moon stood down temporarily from November until early 2015__

We open at 11 a.m. and will have all the usual stalls, cakes, cards, pottery, jewellery and craft items including woodwork. 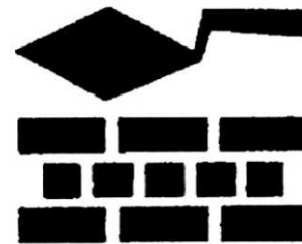

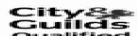

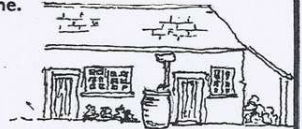

Dear friends

As we turn into Autumn and light up our log fires, we also turn towards the season of remembrance. With the leaves falling from the trees, it is an appropriate time to remember. The leaves fall into the ground in great quantities and colours. They remind us of our loved ones perhaps, who we still love even beyond death. At 6.00pm on 2 November we will mark All Souls Day at Bridge with an Evensong of remembering. The Christian faith teaches us that love is stronger than death, and that nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. The dead are a 'great cloud of witnesses', and we continue to love our loved ones. The following Sunday we remember the 20 million people who perished a hundred years ago in the First World War, and the Second World War that followed less than half a century later. On Sunday 9 November we will lay wreaths at the War Memorials of our villages, and come together at Bridge Church at 1050 in silent reflection for our Remembrance Service. Both to remember and to recommit ourselves to building peace.

Remembering matters. On the washroom walls at Dachau in Germany, a place that I have visited and prayed in, there is the stark sign on the wall 'Those who do not remember will repeat the same again'.

But remembering is not nostalgic nor passive. To actively remember means working to build a better world. Building on the example of our loved ones, actively working to reconcile conflict in the world and to bring peace and reconciliation.

At the end of November, on 30th, we start the holy season of Advent. A time of expectant waiting for both the Christ-child at Bethlehem and the end of time itself.

The real challenge is to resist the Christmas commercial rush and chaos, and enjoy the stillness and expectancy of the four weeks of Advent. To slow down rather than speed up.

As we remember, let us also recommit ourselves to making the world a better place, in which freedom, justice and hope flourish.

Notes from Bridge Parish Council meeting 9th October 2014_

Community First Responder for Bridge- Following a talk and demonstration by Ryan Truelove, Area team leader, it was agreed to encourage residents to volunteer as Community First Responders for Bridge. There was a need for these volunteers because ambulance response times are longer in rural areas. It was hoped to recruit up to 6 volunteers who would undertake to commit to 4-6 hours per week on duty to respond to 999 calls and offer first aid until the arrival of the ambulance service. Volunteers would be selected for training by the Ambulance Service. The Parish Council would make publicity material available in Bridge and consider supporting volunteers by assisting with their equipment costs

Bridge Emergency Plan – Cllr Kate Wortham introduced the new Emergency Plan for Bridge, which had been based on the Kent Resilience Plan. Its aim was to provide local support until the emergency services were available. It was a 'living document' subject to continuous revision. Residents who needed support should be aware it was possible to ask for inclusion on the register. Confidential information would be password protected and securely retained by the Committee members and Parish Clerk. Cllr Sue Hodges thanked the Committee for their hard work in preparing an excellent Plan._

Sand bag storage- It was agreed to approach the Area Manager of Shepherd Neame to ask for permission to site sandbags storage boxes in the car park of the Plough and Harrow

Sports pavilion renovations- Cllr Terry Wilmshurst reported that some work had been started on improving the pavilion. He had replaced 90% of the guttering and had obtained quotations for new floor covering and new showers. . It was agreed that councillors would decide what work was required before the start of the recreation ground working party._

Recreation Ground – The fence between the recreation ground and the health centre needed repairing. This was the responsibility of the surgery. The Play Inspection report had been considered in detail and it had been decided that at present none of the items listed were in need of action but they would be monitored closely. Cllr Brigitte Ward was willing to continue to hold the inspection folder. Cllr Hodges reported that children from the school had planted wild flower plug plants and would plant bulbs the following week. There was the possibility of a butterfly survey next year.

The youth shelter seat had been replaced and Cllr Hodges thanked Cllrs Moon and Wilmshurst for this.

Neighbourhood Plan – The Neighbourhood Plan Committee had met twice in October and would meet again on 17th. October. A meeting had also taken place with representatives of Cantley Ltd, the major local landowner .A draft Plan was almost ready for distribution round the village for residents to comment on. It would be sent to Planning Aid for their assessment. There would be a consultation event in the village hall on 1st November.

Nailbourne – Footings for the floodgates were being installed at the ford in Brewery Lane and road patching was being undertaken in Brewery Lane and Bridgeford Way. It was planned to install a bund and floodgates across the back of Bridge

CHRISTIAN AID AND THE EBOLA EPIDEMIC What Christian Aid is doing in Sierra Leone

Christian Aid is targeting 3.8 million people across the country with potentially life-saving advice on how to avoid contacting this deadly disease. In addition they are providing vital disinfectant and medical kits. So far more than 200,000 pairs of disposable gloves have been distributed to medical teams across nine districts.

Christian Aid's partners in Sierra Leone have also provided more than 360kg of powdered chlorine, with the potential to produce 11,600 gallons of diluted liquid chlorine, to disinfect health centres and for hand-washing by medical teams.

Partner organisations have also trained 900 community health volunteers to conduct house-to-house awareness-raising, with key messages on how to prevent ebola transmission. They then rolled out the training to a further 9,000 volunteers, enabling them to reach nearly 50,000 households across the country.

All this ongoing work in Sierra Leone and other West African countries is made possible by voluntary donations to organisations like Christian Aid. BOURNE VETS NEWS

LITTLE BOY - Mum, can I have a Dog for Christmas?
MUM - No, you can have a Turkey like everyone else.
I hope it goes without saying that it is not a good idea to get an animal as a present. Most rescue centres and any other organisations will be busy with unwanted animals that have been abandoned in the run up to Christmas. Rescue centres are not a good place to go to choose to have a new puppy/kitten or rescue animal. We recommend waiting until the Christmas period is over and your normal routine before introducing your new pet. You will probably have more time to introduce your new pet and settle in properly once Christmas is over.



Christmas can be a stressful time for animals. We see many emergency cases at the practice over the Christmas period and a few of these will be specific Christmas related problems. So, here are some top tips for keeping your pets safe during the Christmas holidays:-

Christmas plants such as Mistletoe, Poinsettias and Amaryllis are poisonous. They can cause stomach and mouth irritations and in extreme cases can be fatal- Mistletoe Berries are particularly toxic.

Fasten Christmas decorations securely. Keep fragile ones, chewable cables and tinsel out of reach.

Try to keep to your pet's usual routine for exercise and meal times.

Do not be tempted to give your pet any leftovers. Sudden changes in diet with rich food can cause diarrhoea and vomiting-a very common Christmas complaint!

Keep chocolates, grapes and raisins out of reach as they are poisonous to pets. We have seen animals that have eaten boxes of chocolates wrapped up under the tree and jumped onto kitchen work surfaces to steal Christmas pudding!

Only give toys that are specifically designed for animals and supervise any new toys to ensure they are safe.

Keep alcohol away from pets.

Take care when you have visitors to ensure that gates and doors are securely closed and make sure your pet has a safe place to retreat away from the hustle and bustle if it becomes too much for them. 



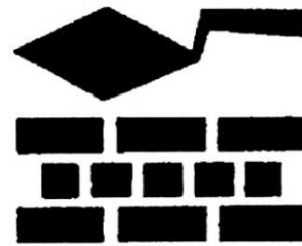
