

As we move through Lent, we come now to Holy Week and Easter. These are the most important and holy times of the Christian year.

On Palm Sunday we remember Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem on a simple donkey, on Maundy Thursday we commemorate the Last Supper with his friends in the upper room, and on Good Friday his brutal death on a wooden cross. The disciples and friends of Jesus were bewildered, lost and frightened when he died. And then three days later on the first Easter Day, a group of women ran to the tomb early in the morning. Met by an angel, they discovered that Jesus was not dead but resurrected. And through this, the end of death itself and the start of hope and new life.

I invite you to enter into the opportunity and depth of Holy Week. This year we will be joined on Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Day at St Peter's Bridge by Bishop Richard Llewellin. Bishop Richard will lead us through the events of the first Holy Week, as we re-live in our own context the drama of 2000 years ago, and experience God in our lives today. On Easter Eve (4 April) at St Peter's Bridge, Justin, our Archbishop and Patron, will join us at 7.30pm to lead the Easter Vigil, Lighting of the Easter Candle, Renewal of our Baptismal Promises and First Eucharist of Easter. Please join us as we proclaim the ancient exclamation 'Alleluia Christ is Risen, He is risen indeed, Alleluia!'.

In the Early Church, Lent was a time of preparation for the Christian life, and so it has been in our community. A group of adults and young people will be Confirmed by Bishop Trevor at St Peter's Bridge on Monday 20 April at 7.00pm. Please come and support them.

This month is the first anniversary of my being your Vicar. Thank you for welcoming me and my family so warmly. May the joy of Easter give us boldness and hope in the Gospel, to witness to our faith in the resurrected Jesus and face the opportunities and the challenges of the future together. We face many. In the world, our Christian brothers and sisters in Syria, the Middle East and parts of Africa, are dying every day for their Christian faith. In next month's magazine I will report on a much smaller issue - the major repairs needed to safeguard and the vision to transform the building of St Peter's Church Bridge.

A very Happy Easter to you and your family!

#### **Recreation Ground**

Cllr Ward reported that mole activity has greatly diminished and thanked all concerned (including children from Bridge Primary School) for the narcissi which look so resplendent. No action is required to replace the flaking paint on the pavilion.

#### Nail Bourne

Cllr Atkinson noted that the groundwater level has stabilised in the local area and current advice from the relevant authorities is that there is no likelihood of flooding of houses this year-despite problems in neighbouring parishes. The ford in Brewery Lane is likely to remain closed for a number of months. There is no sewage being 'over-pumped' into the Nail Bourne at present.

#### Neighbourhood Plan

Mr Connor explained that the Parish Neighbourhood Plan is being revised in the light of comments made on 27 February 2015 by a consultant, Mr Brian Whiteley, of Planning Aid. The next meeting on 10 April will consider his comments in full, though the implementation of the Bridge plan is dependent upon the Canterbury Local Plan being adopted.

#### **Emergency Committee**

Plans are proceeding as outlined in the February 2015 meeting of the Parish Council. Cllr Wortham was pleased to report that BPC has been commended by other local groups as an example of good practice in formulating an emergency plan.

#### Reports from Representatives to Outside Bodies

Cllrs Hill and Atkinson reported on a meeting held with Canterbury City Council on 28 February 2015 to discuss Concurrent Function Funding. Discussion focussed on the apparent unfair treatment of parishes in relation to the urban areas of CCC.

#### **Matters for Discussion and Action**

Saturday 18 April at 9.30 am - village litter-pick to take place. Volunteers will gather at the junction of Conyngham Lane and High Street.

Cllr Wilmshurst reported growing interest in hiring the new pavilion-including a youth club on Saturdays. Booking of the pavilion is likely to be online through the same portal as for booking the village hall. Interested parties should contact Mr Mark Esdale, via the clerk.

Cllr Hill noted that the speaker for the Annual Parish Meeting on 30th April will be Mr Brian Lloyd of the Campaign to Protect Rural England He will talk about the Canterbury District Plan.

It was agreed to place "Bridge in Bloom 2015" on the agenda of the meeting on 14 May 2015.

Councillors agreed unanimously to award the maintenance contract for the recreation ground for 2015-2016 to Mr Ian Sargent of Mown and Grown.

Cllrs Moon and Cook (CCC) spoke on the decision by Canterbury City Council to sell the Mill Centre. Cllr Cook suggested that there is a possibility that the CCC executive decision to sell the centre might be overturned now that decision-making processes in the council elected after 7 May 2015 will no longer be in the hands of an executive group. It was agreed unanimously that all should be done to trigger a six month moratorium on the intended sale.

Cllr Edmonds advised that Bridge's participation in an annual "Walkers are Welcome" festival should be decided upon by the new council after May 7, 2015. Councillors were unanimous in wishing to support the event.

It was agreed to conduct a site visit of the water meadow near the ford to inspect current arrangements for the disposal of dog mess. To be discussed further in April.

Bridge School Summer fair will be held on 13 June 2015.

A Report from the local PCSO ,Lisa Williams, was received on crimes recorded in Bridge since the last meeting.

The next meeting of Bridge Parish Council be on Thursday 9 April 2015 at 7.30 pm in Bridge Village Hall.

more cases of non-specific gastroenteritis which could be caused by mild poisoning. It is mainly dogs that are affected as they are less fussy in what they scavenge and eat but we do see cases of cats that are poisoned too.

The most common poisons that affect pets are:

1 Rodent Poisons ('Rodenticides'), these contain anticoagulants, such as warfarin, which prevent blood clotting. Not all rodenticides are anticoagulants so it is really important to try and find out which one has been ingested. Ingesting these poisons can cause life-threatening bleeding. This bleeding may not appear for several days and may be internal and not visible so it is vital that you seek veterinary attention as soon as possible if you think that your pet may have eaten rat poison.

2 Chocolate, contains the stimulant theobromine which is toxic to

Chocolate, contains the stimulant theobromine which is toxic to dogs. Symptoms of poisoning include vomiting, dehydration, hyperactivity, high temperature and blood pressure, abnormal heart rhythm and tremors.

Grapes, raisins, sultanas and currants, are very toxic for our pets and cooking or baking doesn't reduce the risks. Poisoning causes vomiting and diarrhoea but can lead to kidney failure a few days after the initial effects.

4 Non-Steroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drugs (NSAID's), eg. Ibuprofen. It is not uncommon for us to see dogs that have eaten their owners medication. Symptoms include vomiting, diarrhoea, bleeding internally, stomach ulceration and kidney failure.

Slug Pellets, these contain metaldehyde which is extremely poisonous and is usually fatal without urgent treatment. Dogs that have eaten slug pellets may initially appear unsteady on their feet and twitchy but may rapidly deteriorate and suffer convulsions and possibly respiratory failure.

Antifreeze, this contains ethylene glycol which has a sweet taste that is particularly appealing to cats. Ingesting even the smallest amount can cause kidney failure and death.

If you suspect that you pet may have been poisoned it is essential to seek urgent veterinary advice as the sooner these cases are treated the better chances they have of making a full recovery.
