

The opening of the Churchyard Trail at Bekesbourne Church on 10 May was a wonderful afternoon. The sun shone, we learnt about wild bugs and flying bats, teas were served, the bells rang out, and we ended the day with Evensong. That beautiful service follows the words of Archbishop Cranmer written in 1662 - our next door neighbour to Bekesbourne Church in those days. Walking around the graveyard and finding out about the lives of people buried here, reminded me that we are all part of history and of the 'great cloud of witnesses' that make up the Christian Church. Those who have come before us are part of our church community, but on another shore, and when we celebrate the Eucharist we are joined by all the saints, angels and the company of heaven. So although at times we might feel rather small in number, let us never forget that our churches are already full.

That said, at St Peter's Church Bridge we face the challenge of our crumbling building. We are starting an important process of building a vision, listening to where God might be calling us and how we can respond. On Saturday 27 June there will be a Vision Afternoon (1-4pm) led by the Reverend Peter Ingrams, and all are warmly invited. Easter time was a lively time for us. We had both Archbishop Justin and Bishop Trevor with us, as well as Bishop Richard Llewellin leading Holy Week. On Easter Eve there were three baptisms and on 20 April we had the joyful occasion of the Confirmation of five adults and three young people from across the benefice.

As we look forward to the summer, please do join us at the Bridge and Patrixbourne Church and School Village Fete on Saturday 13 June at the school. It is always a fantastic community event with lots of fun for all ages.





Councillors for the Parish for 2015 are Chairman Andrea Nicholson, Vice- Chairman Julia Maltby, Christine Sladden, Pauline Pritchard, Graham Duplock and David Muggridge. County Councillor Michael Northey attended the meeting, and the bad state of the local roads was discussed. Parishioners are urged to report new potholes on the roads, either to the Clerk, Gail Hubbard, or directly to KCC on their website, and that should result in prompt repair. The budget for future repair work is being decided at present, but resurfacing of the main road from the A2 through the Parish to Littlebourne is unlikely to be a priority item.

The Council discussed the possibility of having a mobile skateboard/bike park at the Recreation Ground for a day during a school holiday, but agreed that the Council would need help with funding this and would investigate sources of financial help for this venture. A request for the provision of such facilities in the Parish has been made by a young Parishioner.

Parishioners will soon receive a questionnaire to ask for views about the need for the provision of more local housing to rent for people with a local connection. If a need is identified then a local housing association may build some new homes in the parish. The survey is being conducted by the Rural Housing Advisor, an independent assessor.

Other items covered at the meeting were the adoption of the 2014 accounts, new financial regulations, the annual risk assessment, and current planning applications. The date of the next meeting is 13th July and all Parishioners are welcome to attend this meeting. The Council currently has vacancies for additional Councillors. If anyone would like to consider becoming a Councillor please contact either the Clerk, or the Chairman, for more details.

#### Minutes of the meeting of Bridge Parish Council held on Thursday 14 May 2015 in Bridge Village Hall

#### Election of Chairman and Vice Chairman

Cllr Alan Atkinson was elected Chairman and Cllr Steve Fawke was elected Vice Chairman.

#### Written report from PCSO Williams

There has been (7) **crime report incidents** in the period 14/04/2015-13/05/2105 for the Bridge and Bekesbourne area.

#### Report from CCC Cllr Simon Cook;

Cllr Cook reaffirmed his election commitment to table a motion to the new City Council in July reversing the decision taken by the previous Executive with regard to the future of the Mill Centre.

#### **Recreation Ground**

The clerk reported that the current contractor for the mowing of the Recreation Ground had requested heavy duty rolling of the grass due to the uneven surface. The Clerk will gather quotations for this work. Cllr Hodges reported on recent voluntary activities on the Recreation Ground including from the local Girl Guides. It was noted that the landowner has taken appropriate landlord actions with regard to illegal access to the Recreation Ground from certain properties on the boundary. The Clerk was asked to inform the landlord of current concerns about this matter.

#### Nailbourne River Management-

Cllr Atkinson stated that the river poses no threat to the village even though there are some emerging issues elsewhere along the course of the river. CCC will decide on the eventual removal of the floodgates in Brewery Lane. This is unlikely to be before June at the earliest.

#### Neighbourhood Plan-

Joe Connor explained that good progress is being made with the revision of the plan. It should be completed by the end of May and the plan then submitted to CCC.

#### Co-opting another councillor.

It was decided to advertise the vacancy as widely as possible, invite written applications by 1 June and to decide on the co-option at an extraordinary meeting of the Parish Council on Thursday 4 June at 7.00 p.m. 7

#### The audited parish accounts for 2014-2015 were signed.

#### The future of the Mill Centre.

The election outcome in Canterbury may well have changed the prospects for the Mill Centre-though the Committee is clear that it cannot afford to buy the building if that is still what is required.

The Clerk will approach parishioners to see if they would be interested in taking this initiative forward.
