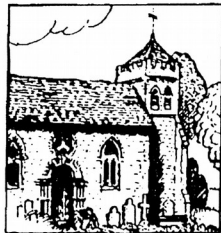

She has no land. No assets. Making manual labour for as little as 74p a day. Her home has been flooded several times, and last August it flooded again. This is Morsheda. She's our neighbour, and she desperately needs our help.

**From 15-21 May, our churches will join with more than 20,000 others across the country for the sake of people like Morsheda.** Across the UK and Ireland we will deliver 7 million envelopes to our local neighbours, to raise money for our global neighbours in need. It's an opportunity to reach out to our community, and to make sure some of the world's poorest people have enough to eat and a safe place to live.

A Home Safety Package from Christian Aid could raise Morsheda's home on an earth plinth, safe from the flood plain, and give her resources to invest in things like farm animals, seeds and a composting kit – the tools she needs to build a better future. A new chance at life for Morsheda costs as little as £250.

**Report from Canterbury City Councillor (Simon Cook)**

The local plan might be adopted by the end of 2016. Responses to local plan amendments have been passed to the Inspector. The city centre car parking consultation is complete. The budget has been set for 2016-2017 with council tax rising by £4.95 per band D property. The allocation of housing on Brickfields will be decided by the government Inspector of the local plan

**Report from Kent County Councillor (KCC) Michael Northey.**

He is pessimistic about the responsiveness of Highway England to representations about the proposed new junction on the A2. They do not appear to be listening to the argument for 4 exits rather than the 3 proposed. KCC have set the budget for 2016-2017 with a reduction of £118m. Council Tax will rise by just under 4% . Consultations on mobile libraries and street lighting are now closed with decisions on both to be announced shortly.

**Information exchange:**

There were 22 volunteers involved in Cleaning for the Queen on Saturday 12 March. 16 bags of rubbish had been filled. Many new litter picking volunteers had come forward.

The pathway in the recreation ground is not "adopted". The Parish Council can therefore determine rules concerning dog fouling.

The Neighbourhood Plan group has been re-energised of late and is holding regular meetings to complete the plan

PCSO Williams' report highlighted 3 recent incidents including damage to the village clock, fly-tipping and an abandoned vehicle.

**Decisions taken in the course of the meeting:**

- 1 All tree applications are to be passed to the Planning Committee for comment.
- 2 The fireworks display will take place on the recreation ground in November 2016.
- 3 A Community Warden for Bridge has been appointed by KCC.
- 4 To receive an update on Green Court developments. Council considered the comprehensive tree report from Lloyd Bore and decided to appoint a committee of councillors to take the initiative forward at the next meeting. KCC will be asked to remove the trees identified as being dead.
- 5 Council agreed to support the changes proposed by Canterbury City Council to parking arrangements in Conyngham Lane.
- 6 Cllr Moon asked that "No parking at any time" notices should be encouraged wherever possible so that parking tickets can be issued.
- 7 Cllr Moon tendered his resignation from the Council with effect from 25 March 2016.

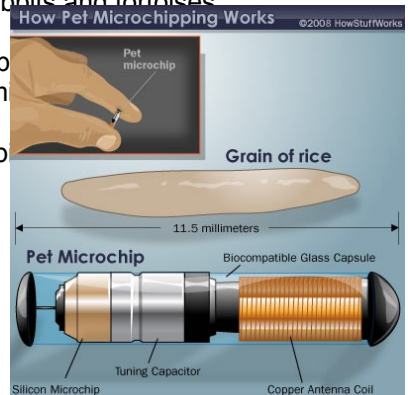
There are no exemptions regarding age, a dog will only be legally exempt if a vet certifies that it cannot be microchipped for health reasons on a form approved by the Secretary of State.

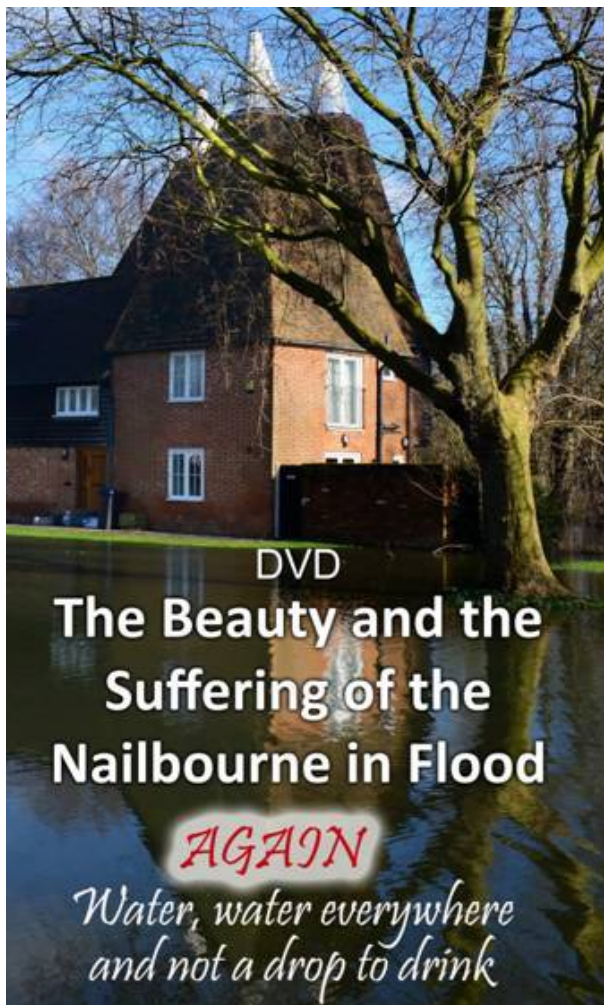
Many of our patients are microchipped but the database registration is not up to date, so if you have moved house or changed your telephone number it is really important to update this information on the database.

Microchipping provides permanent identification of an animal. The microchip cannot be tampered with and once inserted will last a lifetime. The microchip itself is about the size of a grain of rice, encased in a special capsule, designed to sit comfortably under your pet's skin. The implantation is quick and simple – just like an ordinary injection under the loose skin at the back of the neck. At Bourne Veterinary Practice we regularly implant Microchips into dogs, cats, rabbits and tortoises.

## s Cooking?

I love seasonal food, and this is one of the months that chocolate is definitely in season! This is a far richer variant of chocolate mousse, and is the kind of pudding that makes strong men go weak at the knees... the addition of cream changes the texture to a smooth-as-silk deliciousness NOBODY can resist! I first came across this at Stour Music Festival, and it is the magnificent Beryl's signature pudding. Singers don't usually like chocolate as it's supposed to be bad for the vocals, but they tend to make an exception to the rule here. This will serve about 8 people, nominally, and it is very rich.

### **Chocolate Rum Cream**

5 large eggs, separated  
10oz/280g good black chocolate with high cocoa content  
¼ pt rum  
½ pt double cream, softly whipped

To decorate: cream, melted white chocolate or grated dark chocolate

Melt the chocolate in a double boiler or in a bowl over a pan of simmering water. Add a tablespoon of water to the chocolate to stop it from going stiff. Make sure that the mixture doesn't get too hot, and if you are using the bowl over water method, don't allow any water to get in. It is important that all the chocolate is melted, otherwise you get little lumps in the mousse. Add the alcohol and stir it in slowly until smooth.

Add the egg yolks one by one, stirring in, then the whipped cream. Whisk the egg whites until they are standing in stiff peaks. Using a metal spoon, first fold about 1/3 of the whites in to break up the texture, and then add the remaining two thirds.

Pour the creamy mousse into 8 small bowls or ramekins, or into a single bowl, and leave to set. Decorate to taste.

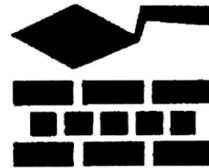
