May is a special month in the life of your local church.

On **1 May** we mark Rogation Sunday. Originally the Christian observance of Rogation was taken over from Graeco-Roman religion, where an annual procession invoked divine favour to protect crops against mildew. The tradition grew of processional litanies around the parish boundaries for the blessing of the land. The Rogation procession was suppressed at the Reformation, but it was restored in 1559. The poet George Herbert interpreted the procession as a means of asking God's blessing on the land, of preserving boundaries, of encouraging fellowship between neighbours with the reconciling of differences, and of charitable giving to the poor. (Evensong at Bridge at 6.00pm)

On **5 May** it is Ascension Day, when we remember Jesus returning to his Father. (Service at Bridge Church at 7.00pm).

On **8 May** we hear about the work of *Christian Aid*, the international development agency, at a special service at 11am at Bridge Church. Christian Aid does amazing work amongst the poorest people in the world, and our fundraising in these villages is always well supported. Thank you!

On **15 May** we celebrate the birthday of the Christian Church - in 2016 we have 2 billion members across the world, and growing. Pentecost is the moment when God sent the gift of the Holy Spirit to the original disciples, and we pray today for the Holy Spirit's work in our lives, community and world.

On **22 May** we mark Trinity Sunday, when we focus on our trinitarian God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The mystery of three in one and one in three.

On **29 May**, our 11.00am Benefice Service will take place not in a church building. Instead we are being invited to worship with residents at Bridge Haven in Bridge, a wonderful care home run by Avante. This will be an important expression that the church community is not confined to buildings, but is out there in the community. Many of the residents have been active in their churches throughout their lives, and they are still an important part of our church community. So May is a full month. And the sunshine is on its way!

One year, it filled up to her knees with floodwater. To stay dry, and keep away from the dangerous snakes that now swam through her home, she raised her bed up on bricks. But during the night she was woken by a loud splash. In the pitch black, her baby son had fallen into the inky water. He could have drowned in moments.



E VETS NEWS

Seeing a dog scooting or dragging its rear end along the ground is quite a strange sight, and often makes people laugh. However, for your dog it is not at all funny as there is often a very irritating reason behind it.

All dogs and cats have anal glands or scent glands situated either side of their bottom that produce a yellow fluid that is used to mark territory and identify other animals. This fluid is normally released when the animal passes faeces or they can spontaneously empty when the animal is stressed and produce a strong unpleasant fishy odour.

Sometimes these anal glands do not empty as they naturally should and so become full. This can cause your pet a lot of pain and discomfort. Dogs will often attempt to ease this irritation by scooting their bottoms along the floor. Other signs of discomfort include licking or biting at their bottom, sitting uncomfortably, chasing their tail or a strong fishy smell!

The glands can also become impacted if the duct leading from the gland becomes blocked which results in very swollen glands and if left untreated they can become infected resulting in abscessation of the area and fever.

If you notice any signs of irritation in your pet we would advise a trip to the vets to get them checked out and have the glands emptied if necessary. This is a straightforward procedure that vets can do in the consulting room with you present. If there is any sign of infection in the glands your pet may need to be prescribed a course of antibiotics. Occasionally it may be necessary to perform surgery to remove the glands if they keep getting infections or if your pet has anal gland tumours, but this is rare.


RETIREMENT OF BRIDGE BUTCHER

Abbreviated Minutes of a meeting of Bridge Parish Council Thursday 14 April 2016 in Bridge Village Hall at 7.30 p.m.

Report from Canterbury City Councillor (Simon Cook)

Cleaning of the A2 is the responsibility of CCC (and not the Highways Agency as reported in March). There will be an A2 littler pick in May. He explained many of the impediments CCC faces to finding an effective cheap and practical solution to the cleaning of the A2 highway and verges.

Report from Kent County Councillor (KCC) Michael Northey.

He focused on the need to ensure the road layout of the new junction on the A2 meets the needs of villagers and on the planned resurfacing of the road from Littlebourne to the A2.

Information exchange:

5 Speedwatch sessions have happened using the newly purchased equipment.

- 28 volunteers were thanked for taking part in the litter pick on the Clean for the Queen event (5/6 March 2016). 24 bags of rubbish were collected. A similar event is to be organised at about the same time as the Queen's birthday party on 12 June 2016.
- CCC has no plans to increase the number or size of litter bins in the village due to financial pressures.
- Council agreed to replace the timber cradle swings with a steel framed set of cradle swings
- Funding has become available for the development of Temporary Relief plans for Bridge. This means that the emergency/instant response plans put together after the 2014 floods will be embedded with equipment purchased and stored for emergency deployment in Bridge.

Decisions taken in the course of the meeting:

- Joe Connor, Chair of the Neighbourhood Plan Group spoke of the next steps to be taken by the Neighbourhood Plan group in light of the preferences expressed in the recent housing consultation. (166 villagers had expressed their preferences; 14% of the electorate). The raw data from this consultation is on the website. It will also be available from the Clerk for those without internet access. Joe Connor will transcribe the comments received as part of the recent consultation for members of the Neighbourhood Plan group.
- Council agreed to write to all residents of Green Court and relevant areas of Western Avenue to seek their involvement in the a working party which will be set to look into plans for improving aspects of the area.

's Cooking?

Always wanting to use seasonaring realents, rimed a variation of a fabulous crunch pie (no, not a cheesecake!), using blood oranges and Yorkshire rhubarb. This would work equally well with standard oranges and garden rhubarb, but perhaps not huge thick green stems of it when it is past its best.

Rhubarb and Orange Crunch Pie

8oz/230g Digestive or Hobnob biscuits, crushed (if you are using digestives, add a tablespoon of demerara sugar)

4oz/110 g butter, melted

Juice and zest of 3 small blood oranges or 1 ½ medium oranges

1 can condensed milk (full fat)

½ pint/300ml double cream

1lb/400g rhubarb

Grease a 9" springclip tin and put baking parchment in the base. Mix the crushed biscuits with the melted butter and spread into the tin, levelling out. Put in the fridge to allow the butter to harden.

Cut the rhubarb into 1" sections, and put into a pan with a small amount of water (about ½ pint/150ml) and some jam sugar to taste. Simmer very gently so that the rhubarb doesn't lose its shape – or simmer a few pieces separately for the top. Save eight or so pieces, and drain the rest, harvesting the sweet juice. Allow to cool.

Whisk the condensed milk, cream, juice and zest together for about 2-3 minutes or so until it has thickened. This is best done with a Kenwood/Kitchen Aid mixer, or at least a deep bowl so you don't redecorate the kitchen!

Pour the rhubarb mixture onto the biscuit base, followed by the thick topping. Level the top and chill for at least half an hour so that it sets. Decorate with the remaining rhubarb. Boil the juice with more sugar until it is just setting (a few minutes at most), cool it slightly, then spoon or pipe it over the top of the pudding. Chill again.


