

During Christian Aid Week children from Bridge and Patrixbourne Primary School made 'worms' of pennies across the playground and raised £177.44 to help families in Bangladesh. They had been learning how people living on the low-lying islands of the Brahmaputra river use worms to make compost, so they can enrich their flood-damaged soil and produce food to keep themselves from starvation.

This wonderful amount helped raise a record £2469.41 in the Benefice this year (plus another £300 once Gift Aid is added).


July 2016 Friends of St Peter's, Bridge

For this and the Choristers in February, and for advertising and marketing, very warm thanks are due to Georgie and Charlie Bainbridge, but a significant number of people have made vital and ongoing contributions, in the spirit of George Herbert's famous poem, "Who sweeps a room as for Thy laws/Makes that and the action fine."

JRNE VETS NEWS

Now the warm summer months are here please remember, don't ever leave your dog alone in the car. When it's 220C/720F outside, the temperature inside a car can reach 470C/1170F within 60 minutes. Dogs pant to keep themselves cool and when the air inside the car becomes hot and stuffy they cannot cool down. Leaving a window open or a sunshield on the windscreen is not enough to keep your car cool – dogs will die in hot cars.

Some dogs are more prone to heatstroke than others. Long haired breeds, fatter or heavily muscled dogs, dogs with shorter snouts and very young or old dogs are all more vulnerable.

Signs that you dog may be suffering from heatstroke include heavy panting, salivation, very red gums and tongue, lethargy, collapse, lack of coordination, vomiting, diarrhoea and eventually loss of consciousness. If you suspect that your dog may be suffering from heatstroke it is important to move them to a shaded area, dowse them with cool (not freezing cold) water and offer them small amounts of water, then ring and seek veterinary advice as soon as possible as this is a veterinary emergency.

vocals, darling...), but nobody resisted this one! The mousse part of is taken from Delicious Magazine's recipe, but I added a dark chocolate base to give it stability and make it easier to cut up. Serves 8-10. It works well with gluten free digestive biscuits. This is not the finished article – puds are transported to Stour undecorated, but it was eaten before I had a chance to take a photo.

White Chocolate Mint Mousse

8oz/225g crushed digestive or Hobnob biscuits

4oz/100g plain dark chocolate

1lb/500g white chocolate (good quality)

1 pint/600ml double cream

2 egg whites

1 tsp peppermint essence (at least – I like a good minty flavour)

Mint leaves to decorate

Dark chocolate to decorate

Use a 9" spring clip tin, and line the base with non-stick parchment. Melt the dark chocolate, either in the microwave, or in a bowl over a pan of simmering water – don't let the water touch the chocolate. Mix in the crushed biscuits and spread it evenly in the tin. Put the base into the fridge while you assemble the mousse. Now melt the white chocolate the same way (it is best to stop heating when it still has visible chunks of chocolate, and allow the residual heat to melt the remaining chocolate). Allow this to cool a bit – this is important, because otherwise it goes stiff when you add the cream.

Whip the double cream and egg whites, with the peppermint, until it is starting to thicken, but still soft (taste and add more peppermint at this point if you like an intense burst of flavour). Fold an initial spoonful of cream into the chocolate to break it up a bit, then fold in the rest of the cream, stirring gently until it is smooth. Pour over the biscuit base and chill for at least two hours.

Decorate with mint leaves and grated dark chocolate and serve not quite straight from the fridge, but slightly warmer so that the peppermint flavour sings through (like a good soprano soloist!).


