Dear Friends

Well we made the papers again with the lovely donkey that accompanied us on Palm Sunday! We had a beautiful day for that service and a full church and full congregations throughout the Benefice again on Easter Sunday (who were I hope not too alarmed by the Vicar's April Fool's day trickery!). We have also held each of our Parish's Annual Meetings at which all were pleased to report that our buildings are in good condition and our finances are holding up thanks no small part to all the volunteers who work to keep our churches going and all those who support our various 'Friends' groups.

This month as we settle into a more regular rhythm of life in our churches following the seasons of Lent and Easter we still have much going on and much to celebrate. In our churches May is all about the aftermath, the fall-out if you will of the extraordinary event of the Resurrection – the 'what happened next?'. On May 10th we will commemorate Jesus' ascension with a service of Holy Communion at Lower Hardres at 7pm and then ten days later, on Sunday 20th May we will celebrate the birthday of the Church (Pentecost) in joyful style with a Benefice Family Communion Service at Bekesbourne Church – we do very much look forward to welcoming you to Bekesbourne for this service.

May is also a time when we seek to reinvigorate our prayer life so during the nine days between the Ascension and Pentecost we will be joining with Christians throughout the World engaging in prayer through the 'Thy Kingdom Come' initiative. Canterbury diocese has produced Novena prayer booklets for us to use and here in our Benefice we will be holding 9 Prayer events to which all are welcome (details of which can be found elsewhere in the magazine). If you've never tried prayer, if you're a bit mystified by church, if you're worried about whether you would know what to do etc. give it try at one of our 9 events – they are all different, on different times and days and in different places around the benefice. You can be assured of a warm welcome as we gather together to try praying in different ways.

I am still keen to get out and about and to meet as many of you as possible (although the work of the Benefice often keeps me desk bound!) Do give me a ring or drop me an e-mail if there is something you'd like me to come along to or if there is anything you think we in the church can help with.

Annual Parochial Church Meetings 2018 Update!

During April the three ecclesiastical parishes of our Benefice held their Annual meetings and presented their reports and accounts for the year up to the end of December 2017.

The meetings were all very positive as the parishes were able to report on the good state of their church buildings and financial accounts. This is wholly due to the work which keeps your churches open and functioning and which is carried out in the main by committed teams of **volunteers** who all give of their time and expertise.

Local churches **receive no direct funding** from The Church of England at a national level or from central government and rely on the regular giving of those who attend and the fundraising efforts of those who support through events and activities run through groups such as the 'Friends of' groups which are active in all of our churches – again thanks to the energy of volunteers.

In the year up to the end of December 2017 your church councils were able to demonstrate that the parishes were viable and capable of sustaining the ministry costs of a full time Vicar, which many of you will know some other communities have not been able to do.

Whilst many value the presence of beautiful churches in their communities most are unaware of the work and the challenges that go into maintaining the churches and keeping them in a safe and good state to be able to welcome the wider community for family events such as weddings and christenings and the popular festivals at Christmas and Easter.

CHRISTIAN AID WEEK 13 - 19 MAY 2018





Everyone needs a place to call home. This flimsy shack was home to a family in Haiti before the earthquake struck in 2010. It didn't stand a chance. 220,000 people died and 1.5m were made homeless. Nearly 6,000 died later from cholera in the camps for displaced refugees.

<u>Could it get any worse?</u> Yes - in 2016 the island was struck by Hurricane Matthew, with further loss of life, serious injury, destruction of homes and loss of livestock and possessions.

But this time there were signs of hope. Christian Aid had been there all the time, working with its partner organisation, Korai, to build disaster-resistant homes for the displaced Haitian people. Of the dozens of new homes they managed to build before the hurricane, only one lost its roof; the others stood firm.

But there is still much to be done. This Christian Aid Week please give generously so that this work of re-building Haiti can continue. Collectors from the Benefice will be dropping the familiar red envelopes in your letter boxes and coming back later to collect your donations. We have a loyal band of collectors but if we had more, we could cover more roads. If you can help, please make contact. There will be envelopes available in the churches if we don't manage to reach you.

FOOD BANK

Why is there a need for a Food Bank in the area?

It could arise from a sudden change in circumstances, such as family break-up, illness, unexpected bill, redundancy or even reduced working hours which can result in people unable to feed themselves and their families, even in our apparently affluent corner of Kent.

A huge thank you to everyone in our local villages for supporting this cause by donating directly to the yellow bin in St Peter's Church, Bridge, and especially to those who heeded my earlier request for much needed UHT milk and juice and canned vegetables. This was gratefully received at the Collection Centre.

The items are sorted into three main bags: Adult 1, Adult 2 and children.

The children's bags contain: UHT fruit juice and UHT full fat milk, cereal, biscuits, baked beans x2, tinned pasta, soup, pasta sauce, canned vegetables x2, dried pasta/ potatoes, tinned meat x2, tinned tuna, jam, tinned fruit and a dessert (tinned or UHT). In the week leading up to Easter, 140 bags were filled to order following requests from several of the local schools in the Canterbury/Herne Bay/Whitstable area for handing out to children deemed to be in need. These all contained the above, together with an Easter Egg.

Next time: the Bonus Table at the Distribution Café and what is a Morsbag? Making one of these could help to cut out the use of plastic bags at the Distribution centres in our area. I will find out more about them and pass this on.


