



Dear Friends

As I write this the darkness of winter has begun to draw in, the days seem short and increasingly a bit grey and we have had lots of rain! In spite of this though we have enjoyed some wonderful entertainments in and/or for the benefit our churches recently; a barn dance at Bekesbourne, The Snowdown Colliery choir at Patrixbourne, Harvest Supper and Lunch at Lower Hardres and the highly creative Narropera at Nackington. One of the recent highlights in the life of the Church of St Peter's in Bridge has been the installation and dedication of a new stained glass window in the West End of the Church. It was a joy to welcome the Archbishop of Canterbury to a special service at which the window was dedicated to the memory of Tom Stewart who died as a result of cot death in 1974. The window itself is a representation of the journey of a life of faith, lived out in spite of personal tragedy, and a powerful reminder that we can honour those we have loved and lost, even in tragic circumstances, not by trying to keep them alive but by naming and acknowledging their death and making the most of life and the living.

This is helpful as we enter the 'season of Remembrance' beginning with All Saints and All Souls at the beginning of November and continuing with Remembrance Day (11th) and our Church commemorations which will take place on Sunday 10th. We remember those who gave their lives in war, not for the purpose of glorifying war, not for the purpose of seeking to hold on to the lives that were lost, because we cannot bring them back, but to ensure that we commemorate the preciousness of all life and value every moment of the gift of life that we have been given. Dear Friends of Bridge School,

As part of our welcome to Bridge School, our youngest children were invited, with their parents, to St Peter's Church to take part in a short welcome service. This was very well attended by the parents and I'd like to thank Julia Perfect, Rev. Estella and her team of church wardens for organising this and making us feel so welcome.

In our Collective Worship, we have been reflecting upon our Christian Values and giving thought to where the children have had the opportunity to demonstrate these.
